- This program provides excellent opportunities for students 15 and over to get work-based training in a wide range of apprenticeable trades.
- There are many benefits of the SSA program – 16 credits towards graduation, get a head start on an apprenticeship, earn while you learn, be prepared for life after high school with appropriate skills, attitudes and hours logged towards apprenticeship, \$1,000 scholarship with a C+ average on grade 12 courses.

Automotive Service Technician – January 30 to July 31, 2012

- This program provides excellent opportunity for students to learn the theory of the level 1 auto service technician apprentice while still in high school.
- There are many benefits of this ACE IT program – earn 20 credits towards graduation, get a head start on an apprenticeship, be prepared for life after high school with appropriate skills, attitudes and AST level 1 credit and free post secondary tuition.
- The program is 6 months long and consists of 3 parts:
 - 4 months at Aldergrove Community Secondary School
 - 1 month at Kwantlen Cloverdale and
 - 1 month of automotive work experience
