2. **The Eagle program** is based on elements of the highly successful **Reading and Culture** and **PALS** programs and includes an Aboriginal literacy focus to build both confidence in early reading ability and cultural pride.
3. Registration forms for the **Eagle program** will be available at all schools.
4. **The Eagle program** offers students free busing from their catchment-area school and a return ride home.
5. **The Eagle program** is scheduled to begin in September 2012 with a gradual entry.
6. **The Eagle program** also offer **PALS**, a program where Elders from the community share their teachings with children and their families.
