Transportation Notice for 2011/12 School Year

Parents of Students who use the Langley School District Transportation System

In the last few years there has been a reduction in ridership. The District must also address the Deficit Elimination Plan. The Transportation Department is beginning a review of all routes and some routes may be altered or eliminated based on registration for September 2011.

At this time, the District will be eliminating the Eagle K route and Betty Gilbert/Parkside shuttle route. Also being eliminated will be busing from the Walnut Grove area to Mountain Secondary School.

If your child/children meet the eligibility requirements as set out in Board Policy 3850, a seat will be made available for them.

In order to map out the routes, all registrations must be received by June 3, 2011. All registrations must be accompanied by payment and can be sent to the School Board Office located at 4875-222 St., Langley, B.C., V3A 3Z7. The bus that your child is on may contain a video surveillance camera. The purpose of the camera is an effort to reduce vandalism and have an impartial witness to issues arising during the normal course of operation.
