**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SCHOOL STATUS DURING
INCLEMENT (BAD) WEATHER**

DO NOT CALL THE SCHOOL AS THE SECRETARY CAN NOT ANSWER SO MANY PHONE CALLS, HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

Snow closures and power outages are an annual occurrence in the Langley School District. So where do you go to get information about the status of schools during periods of inclement weather? By 6:30 AM or earlier information about the status of Langley Schools is available. If you have power in your home and an internet connection, **current information about Langley schools can be accessed at www.sd35.bc.ca. Click on the "School Status"** quick link in the right menu of the district home page. If you don't have connectivity, but your phone is working, call a relative or friend in an area that has not been affected by the storm and ask them to check the district web site for you. A message is also recorded on **Langley School District's Information Hotline at 604-532-1453** (do not hang up if your call is not connected right away). **The district also sends updates to radio stations CKNW (980 AM), CKWX (1130 AM) and Country Radio (107.1 FM). Parents are asked to NOT call their child's school** or the School Board Office reception desk for school status updates.
