Here's How It Works:

1. Students selected to participate in the program:

- Choose up to a maximum of 2 courses from a list of courses offered by Kwantlen Polytechnic University
 - courses included in the XCEL program cover a range of concentrations; some being considered are criminology, international relations, marketing, business management, psychology and sociology
 - the first course takes place in the fall semester starting in September and the second course takes place in the winter semester starting in January.
- receive a Kwantlen Polytechnic University orientation highlighting the student services available to them on campus
- receive support as a program participant to successfully navigate all aspects of their post secondary experience

BENEFITS TO PARTICIPATING

- head start on university education while still in high school
- free tuition and student fees
- earn dual credit:
 - earn secondary school credit for 2 high school elective courses (8 credits).
 - earn university credit towards a 4-year degree
- waived Kwantlen Polytechnic University application fee
- additional guidance and support to access university for the first time
- a bursary program for students with financial hardship

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 11 completed
- Fully proficient in the English language
- eligible for admissions to Kwantlen Polytechnic University
- B (minimum) in English 11, Socials 11 and either Science or Math 11
- Demonstrated motivation and engagement in the learning environment (2 references from either an administrator, counselor and teacher)
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Meet with your school's XCEL contact for initial interview and application package
- Complete application. Collect references and other supporting documents and submit to your school's XCEL contact.
- You will be informed of your status in the program by the end of April.

STUDENT COSTS:

- Kwantlen has waived the Application Fee (a savings of \$40.00).
- The District pays the cost of tuition (a savings of ~\$400 per course) as well as student fees (a saving of ~\$60).
- Students are required to purchase their own textbooks (~\$125 per course).
