## Why Are You Here?

#### **Board of Education Meeting - June 16, 2015**

- That the Board of Education approves that staff work with the community, schools and the Township of Langley to maintain the current configuration of schools (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) on the Willoughby slope.
- That the Board of Education requests that staff begin the process, as outlined in the "Willoughby Slope Spring 2015 Consultation" report, of re-drawing school catchment boundaries on the Willoughby slope for the 2017-2018 school year.

  - The Board requested a secondary school
- A new school close to REMSS and the LEC
- Previous Five Year Capital Plan
  - Further land acquisition for the next elementary school
    - An increased priority
