**4 Levels:**

- Beginner/Development Level
  - Ages of students: 9-19
  - Credits: Minimum 4 credits
  - Fees: \$3000 per student. Includes one year of riding, stable management and add on equestrian workshops, events and experiences.
- Competition Level
  - Ages of students: 15+
  - Credits: Minimum 12 credits
  - Fees: \$3000 per student. Includes one fulltime teacher mentor and one fulltime equine mentor.
- Elite Level
  - Ages of students: 15+
  - Credits: Minimum 12 credits
  - Fees: \$5000 per student. Includes one fulltime teacher mentor and one fulltime equine mentor.
- Work experience (equine related)
  - Ages of students: 16+
  - Credits: Minimum 4-16 credits
  - No Fee. Exploratory placements in 120 hours of equine related work experience or intensive working student placements of 480 hours.

Academy fees can be paid in installments. The hardship policy applies to all students enrolled.

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
