

## 2019 Secondary Classes - Grade 8 to 12

### Full Credit

Students can complete Full Credit classes as long as they have completed the prerequisite course with a 'C+' or higher or have taken the course before. Students can take 1 or 2 courses from the list below but should remember that Summer Session classes are very concentrated and involve a high commitment in a short period of time.

### General Academic Remedial

Students taking Academic Remedial classes must have already taken the course and received a mark of at least 35% but have not met the learning outcomes or have only done so at a minimal level. Students can take a maximum of two Remedial classes and will be able to earn the course credit and a **maximum** mark of 61% (C).

### Math 8 / 9 Remedial or Preview

Students taking Academic Remedial Math 8 or 9 classes must have already taken the course and received a mark of at least 35% but have not met the learning outcomes or have only done so at a minimal level. Students will receive the course credit with the assigned mark in Math 8 or 9 if they have previously taken the course.

Students who have never taken Math 8 or 9 may "Preview" either course to better prepare for the full course they take next year, **but will not receive credit.**

## Registration - Current Langley School District Students - April 8 to June 26

Summer Session 2019 registration in the Langley School District opens April 8, 2019 for students currently enrolled in the Langley School District. Secondary class registration closes June 26. Please note that priority is given to students currently registered in the Langley School District based on space and staffing availability. Registrations in available classes are processed in the order the registration occurs, on a “first-come, first-served basis”.



## Registration - Out of District Students - May 1 to June 26

Summer Session 2019 registration for out-of-district students (any students not currently registered in the Langley School District) opens on May 1, 2019. Starting on May 1, 2019, out-of-district students can register for available Summer Session 2019 classes but the registration will continue to be “pending” and not finalized until after June 14, 2019. Out-of-district student’s registration will need to be confirmed in person at the Langley School Board Office within 7 days of registering or they will be withdrawn. The registration for out-of-district students will only be approved and finalized if there is space and staff available in Summer Session at that point.

## Information Required When Registering

- Student’s Personal Education Number (PEN), student’s legal and English name if different, phone number(s), address, and parent guardian(s) name(s) and e-mail address.
- If student was not registered in the Langley School District for the 2018/19 school year, proof of parent / guardian(s) Citizenship and BC residency plus the student’s birth certificate must be provided.

## Student Attendance in Summer Session

- ✓ **Students are expected to attend all sessions of a class they are registered for.** Absence of more than 2 days may result in withdrawal from courses. Students should not be registered for Summer Session if extended absence for any reason is anticipated (e.g. work, vacations, sporting events, family commitments).

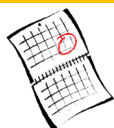
## International Students

- Secondary International students already registered in the Langley School District must contact their International Student Program (ISP) Coordinator at their current school before registering in Summer Session classes for full information regarding payment options and to confirm homestay arrangements.
- Elementary and Middle Years International students can register for their course online or in-person as outlined above and must make their payments and complete their registration in person at the Langley School Board Office.
- All International students are subject to course fees as outlined on the front of this brochure. Payment of course fees must be made within 7 days of registration.
- International students withdrawing from courses are subject to a 10% processing fee. Refunds are not given after the first day of Summer Session 2019 classes have started.
- International students not currently enrolled in the Langley School District must contact the ISP Department if they have questions about eligibility to enroll in Summer Session 2019, noting that registration would be after May 1, 2019.
