




ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL TERRITORIES

That *trust* between communities and the District be developed and maintained throughout the process.




That the District *listen* to communities and sincerely reflect on feedback and ideas.




That the District *value and honour* community members and treat them with respect.




