Every school has a Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) that represents parents of the school and engages in educational programs and fundraising. The PAC is an entity that is separate from the School District and is operated and administered by a group of parents at your local school. All parents are eligible to participate in the PAC group at their school.

The School District typically provides each PAC with information including the names, student names and contact information for parents at the school. This information is used by the PAC for the purposes of communicating with parents about PAC events and initiatives, verifying membership and identity, and supporting the school in the event of an emergency by helping to notify the parent community about issues of concern.

The information provided will include only: Parent/Guardian names, child's name, grade and division, email address and telephone numbers. No other personal information regarding your family is given to the PAC.
